- The advertised business on any day may be interrupted for a Ministerial statement
- The number of sessions shown for a stage of a bill represents the Government's assessment of reasonable time given the balance of bills and remaining days to the likely end of the session. Progress remains in the hands of the House. Report stage is usually half the length of Committee

## **Recess dates**

Subject to the progress of business, the House will be adjourned during the following periods in 2020:

- *Summer*: Thursday 30 July to Tuesday 1 September inclusive

## **Sitting Fridays**

The House is expected to sit on 10, 17 and 24 July to consider Government business. Further sitting Fridays will be announced in due course.

## **Questions for short debate**

A member who wishes to ask a QSD must first table it with the clerks in the Table Office. The question is then printed in a running list in House of Lords Business, a House publication. Members should then consult the Government Whips' Office to agree upon a suitable date when the question can be asked.
